# Normal Eye

In the normal eye, light from distant objects is focused on the retina resulting in sharp vision.





# Myopic Eye


In the nearsighted eye, light from distant objects is focused in front of the retina resulting in blurred vision.

# Hyperopic Eye

In the farsighted eye, light from distant objects is focused too weakly for the length of the eye resulting in blurred vision.
